



Rhythm Guitar




F5 - 1st fret


E b - 3rd fret

C 5 - 3rd fret



C 5 - inverted



Lead Guitar - tuned to D..B..D..G..B..E




Cmajor - 5th fret


Bb - 3rd fret


F Major - 10th fret


E b - 8th fret
